## **Dress Code**

Proper attire is always required throughout the Club. Anyone improperly dressed will be asked to change before engaging in golf, pool, or tennis activities.

#### 1. Golf Facilities

- Appropriate golf attire includes slacks, chino-style pants, skirts/skorts, and golf shorts that are no more than six inches above the knee. Golf shirts, mock turtlenecks, and tailored shirts are acceptable and should be tucked in.
- The following items are prohibited: jeans or denim of any color, strapless/ halter/crop tops, t-shirts, sweatpants, cargo shorts, athletic shorts, bathing suits, cut-offs and flip flops/sandals/Crocs.
- Appropriate golf shoes shall be worn on the golf course at all times. Metal spikes are not allowed.

#### 2. Pool Facilities

- Proper swimwear is required by everyone using the pool facilities.
- Appropriate swimwear includes swim trunks, water shirts, and bathing suits made of material designed for use in aquatic facilities. (Clothing not designed with waterfriendly fabric is more likely to carry bacteria into our pools.)
- Disrobing of undergarments in public or in parking areas is not permitted, regardless of age. Please use the locker rooms.

#### 3. Tennis Facilities

- Clay court tennis shoes ONLY. (No joggers, cross trainers, ridged or cleated soles.)
- No Denim or Swimwear.
- No sleeveless shirts for men or boys.
- Proper Athletic attire required. Non-tennis graphic shirts not permitted.





# **Code of Conduct**

Harrrison Meadows Country Club ("HMCC") is a premier country club that fosters a culture that values, appreciates, and respects all its members, their families, guests, and staff members. We expect that all individuals will treat each other and staff members in a positive, respectful manner at all times. This code of conduct policy is designed to ensure that all members, family members, and guests of our club will abide by a set of standards that reflect our commitment to fostering a welcoming and inclusive environment for all.

#### 1. Respectful and Inclusive Behavior

We expect all individuals to behave in a respectful and inclusive manner towards each other and staff members at all times. Discrimination or harassment of any kind, including but not limited to racism, sexism, ageism, and homophobia, will not be tolerated.

#### 2. Compliance with Club Policies and Rules

All members, family members, and guests of our club must comply with our club policies and rules at all times. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to suspension, revocation of membership or a ban from the club.

#### 3. Responsible Use of Club Facilities

All individuals are expected to use club facilities in a responsible and respectful manner. This includes proper use of golf carts, adherence to dress codes, respectful behavior on the golf course, in the restaurants, at the pool, and during all events. Good sportsmanship is an expectation for everyone.

#### 4. Professional Conduct

All individuals are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner while on club premises.

This includes respectful behavior towards staff members, other members, and guests, and adherence to club policies and rules.

Members, family members and guests are strictly prohibited from reprimanding, disciplining, or addressing staff performance issues. This responsibility lies solely with the management team and supervisory staff. Members, family members and guests should not engage in any behavior that can be perceived as disciplinary action, nor should they address any staff performance issues with the staff member in question or their colleagues. All complaints or suggestions about staff performance should be made in writing and addressed to the appropriate member of management.

At all times, members are expected to cooperate in a courteous and respectful manner with members of HMCC management and staff compliance with this code of conduct or any other HMCC by-law, rule regulation, procedure, restriction or instruction.





# **Code of Conduct**

#### 5. Safe and Healthy Environment

All individuals are prohibited from creating an environment that endangers the welfare, safety, harmony, or good reputation of HMCC, its members, family members, guests or staff members. This includes but is not limited to, physical threats, verbal abuse, harassment, or any other behavior that may cause harm or injury to another. Members, family members and guests must also follow all safety protocols and guidelines established by HMCC and refrain from engaging in any activities that could potentially harm themselves or staff members including:

- a. Deliberate or careless damage or destruction of any HMCC property, or the property of any club member or employee.
- b. Removing or borrowing HMCC property or assets without prior authorization.
- c. Unauthorized use of HMCC equipment, time, materials, or facilities.
- d. Provoking a fight or fighting at any time on the property.
- e. Carrying fire arms or any other dangerous weapons on the property at any time.
- f. Commission of a crime or engaging in criminal conduct of any sort.
- g. Causing, creating, or participating in a disruption of any kind on the property.
- h. Use of abusive or threatening language toward any member, family member, quest, or staff member.
- i. Violating any safety, health, security or HMCC policy, rule, or procedure.
- j. Committing or involvement in any act of unlawful harassment of another individual.

#### 6. Reporting Violations

If any individual observes a violation of this code of conduct policy, they are encouraged to report it to the management team immediately. The management team will investigate any reported violations and take appropriate action.
