Program Overview



The HMCC Summer Camp provides a comprehensive program that includes instruction in golf, tennis, pickleball, and swimming, complemented by field sports for children ages 7 to 12. Additional activities include craft and team-building workshops designed to foster creativity and leadership.

Golf activities are conducted at our driving range, short game area and putting green, where campers learn swing mechanics, putting & proper golf etiquette under the guidance of PGA-certified professionals.

Tennis instruction takes place on our Har-Tru courts led by USTA-certified instructors. Pickleball instruction is also offered and led by certified instructors.

Swim instruction and recreational swim time is overseen by instructors and coaches certified by the Red Cross and the USAA. All activities follow strict safety guidelines and supervision protocols.
