Court Rules/ Reservations

- All players are required to sign up for the court via HMCC online court reservation system. Members who are unable to use the reservation system should contact the tennis office to book a court.

- Walk - ons are welcome, although court space cannot be guaranteed.
- Courts may be reserved for a maximum of 1.5 hours, except on holiday weekends (Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day).
- Pickleball Court reservations are for a maximum of 1 hour.
- Member can book a court a maximum of 7 days in advance.
- No back-to-back reservations permitted.
- Juniors cannot play on the weekends and holidays prior 1pm.
- Courts are CLOSED between 1pm and 2pm for watering and maintenance.
- All GUESTS must be **SIGNED IN** at the tennis office prior play.
- There is **24 hours cancellation policy** for all lessons, clinics and events.
- Weekday Members will be charged Non - Member fee to play in prime time (Friday - Sunday).
- The Tennis Shop will always notify you if your clinic or lesson is cancelled due to inclement weather.

Dress Code

- Clay court tennis shoes ONLY (no joggers, cross trainers, Crocs, bare feet, crested soles)
- No Denim or Swimwear.
- No sleeveless shirts for men or boys.
- No Large graphic shirts
